health or safety or for the protection of other people and treatment can t be given unless you are detained in hospital you cannot be sectioned under this section unless the doctors also agree that appropriate treatment is web section 3 of the mental health act is commonly known as treatment order it allows for the detention of the service user for treatment in the hospital based on certain criteria and conditions being met these are that the person is suffering from mental disorder and that the mental disorder is of a nature or a degree which warrants their care web section 3 admission section 3 of the mental health act web to be detained under section 3 mental health 1983 as amended mha 1983 you must meet the following criteria you must be suffering from a mental disorder of a nature and or degree which makes it appropriate for you to be liable web under a section 3 you can be detained for up to six months in the first instance this could be renewed for a further six months and then for periods of one year at a time section 3 can only be renewed following an assessment by the doctor responsible for your care responsible clinician or rc web section 3 admission for treatment this is the long term civil section an amhp makes an application for admission based on the recommendations of two medical practitioners the initial period for which detention is authorised is six months but it can be renewed by the rc for a further six months then for further periods of 12 months web landlords and agents can be required to provide a specific name or address in a number of different circumstances as these circumstances are covered by different legislation some will require the landlord s name and their real address while others only require an address in england or detained you can be kept for up to 72 hours this gives the hospital time to arrange a full assessment web when you purchase a freehold property you are legally required to inform tenants of the assignment of landlord s interest as per the landlord and tenant act 1985 this is called a section 3 notice and it must be served within two months following the transfer of ownership and contain the
